From 2014 until 2016, Vivian Bercovici served as Canada's Ambassador to Israel.

Appointed by Prime Minister Stephen Harper, she quickly established a reputation as a highly engaged, articulate and personable diplomat and a very effective advocate for the strong Canada-Israel relationship.

Having practiced law for 24 years in Toronto, Vivian infused this role with a strong, pragmatic political and business-oriented approach.

Throughout her legal career, Vivian has been involved in a broad range of community organizations and has served on several Boards, including the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation.

She is an executive fellow at The School of Public Policy at the University of Calgary and a senior fellow at the Jewish People Policy Institute (Jerusalem). She writes a monthly column in The Jerusalem Post and aspires to author a book.

Vivian's primary focus is as Managing Director of Nuuvera Israel, a subsidiary of Nuuvera Corp. (Canada), a global agricultural company engaged in advanced growing and production methods.

Vivian resides in Tel Aviv with one of her two young-adult daughters.
