The Torah Tidbits distribution for Netanya, and nearby communities is quite a complex undertaking, which I have been handling for almost two years now. I hope to keep doing it for as long as possible.

This will require a bit of assistance, from time to time. I am hoping to get that help from those who benefit from my efforts, along with the efforts of Mrs. Toni Chernofsky, of the OU in Jerusalem, and Rabbi Baruch Taub, who teaches a shiur at the OU each week.

For the past few weeks, in the absence of Rabbi Taub, who generally transports the Torah Tidbits from the OU Center, in Jerusalem, to me, here in Netanya, I have been travelling as far as Petach Tikva and Bet Shemesh to retrieve these Magazines. It has become quite an onerous burden, especially for a voluntary service to the community.

Therefore, I am calling upon you to take a more active role in getting the Tidbits to us. I need you to make announcements in your shuls, during services, so that people will know when we need to have them delivered to Netanya. ***The next time is Wednesday, March 21, and Thursday, March 22.*** The members of your shuls should see if they, themselves, are visiting Jerusalem on pick-up days, have other guests who are coming to visit them, or various, and sundry, other ways. If you can get them anywhere near Netanya, I am willing to retrieve them, and deliver them to you.
