Beyond Politics: An Insider's View of the UN

Paulette Woolf was Deputy Director of the Management, Evaluation and Consulting Division of the Office of Internal Oversight Services at the United Nations. Prior to that, she was Chief of the internal Management Consulting Section which was devoted exclusively to providing management consulting services to UN departments world-wide.

In 2015, she was requested by the Israeli government to lecture on the United Nations to students at Tel Aviv University, IDC and Bar Ilan University.

Paulette has now established her own consultancy practice, called Woolf Strategies. This year, she was in Nepal for three weeks on a consulting assignment for UNICEF and in Nairobi for two weeks teaching transformative leadership.

Paulette and her husband, Rabbi David Woolf, made Aliyah in September 2016.
